2016-2017 Goal

Work with community, parents, students, school staff, county staff, and professionals to define the educational specifications and to create the conceptual design for a major high school renovation that will prepare students for success in a global economy.

Process

 Gloucester County Public Schools will host members of the community to a showing of the film <u>Most Likely to Succeed</u>, which highlights effective learning strategies that prepare students for the future in an inviting learning environment.

- In conjunction with the film, the viewers will be invited to tour the existing Gloucester
 High School facility and interact with other attendees, teachers and students.
- Avenues for viewers to provide input will be made available in the days that follow so that feedback may be received by the School Board. Results will be posted for the community to view.

 In the same venue the School Board staff will view the same film on an in-service day. Similarly they will have the opportunity to discuss and interact with their colleagues, and join the community in providing input and feedback.

 A conceptual design committee will be formed which will include a cross section of the community as follows: parents, students, school staff, county staff, business professionals, etc. A design team will be contracted to work with the committee to create the conceptual drawings and presentation documents.

 A recommendation from the committee for renovations and improvements will be presented to the community before moving forward to the School Board and Board of Supervisors. Approval of the Boards will move the process forward with preparation of the engineering design and specifications.
